All items were discussed in a round-table format

- Website has been updated. Local summer soccer camps will be posted on the site.
 - Fliers were handed out at evals for the EYSA/Reading AC camp
- The 990 form has been filed for tax purposes.
- We need to resurrect and/or create job descriptions for all Board positions as we work on updated bylaws and articles of incorporation.
- Approximately 590 players have registered for the fall season.
 - Refund checks will be issued to the few withdraws and the four players from New Hampshire that registered.
- Cindi needs the coach/team assignments by July 1 to register the teams (do not need the players by that date)
 - Coaches will need to be approved at the June Board meeting
- Pete talked to Mark Yocum about the U12 & U13 teams that will have more than 18 players. He wasn't very understanding and didn't have suggestions on how to handle the situation.
- We will not do a 3v3 tournament this year. There is not enough time or volunteer support to make it happen.
- A third color of pinnies will be bought for evals next year to make small group play easier to manage
- We need to figure out how to do nets, cones and balls for the youth program
 - Pete and Rich will try to get advance copies of the curriculum from Duncan at Xara
- We will only provide game balls to coaches this fall (players should bring their own ball to practice)
- We will try sandbags rather than anchors at some of the Township fields this summer to facilitate mowing and maintenance
- We are looking into a gas powered striping machine to save money on paint
