Dear Exeter Soccer Players and Families:

Your EYSA Board of Directors is already hard at work for the FALL soccer season. 2010 will be full of player clinics, coaching classes and more updates on our website. We are excited about all of this and are anxious to get started! Fall soccer registration is currently open. Online Registration is currently available on our website at www.eysasoccer.com.

Fall 2010 registration will be for both boys and girls ages 5 to 18 (as of July 31, 2010).
Registration runs from today through April 6th. Late registration runs from April 7th through May 9th.
Players must be registered by May 9th and attend evaluations to be eligible for a travel 1 team

Registration Assistance: EYSA will have the following three nights available at the Exeter Community Library from 6 to 8 p.m. to help with online registration, uniform sizing and sign-up sheets for volunteers and coaches. We encourage you to attend one of the three nights so we can meet you and help with your registration needs.

All first-time players must bring a photocopy of their birth certificate and purchase a uniform at registration.

Uniforms: All players MUST be sized for a uniform at one of the 3 sessions at the Exeter Community Library. The uniform for U9 and above includes a jersey, alternate jersey, shorts, and socks. **Cost of the uniform will be \$60, and is due at one of the registration nights. (Uniforms cannot be ordered on-line). ALL PLAYERS (EXCEPT U14) MUST** order new uniforms. Anyone who does not order their uniform on one of these nights must go to the Sneaker Villa in the Exeter Promenade for the upcoming season. If your uniform is not ordered by June 1st, there is no guarantee it will be available by August 1st. Fall registration fee includes a full uniform for U6, U7 and U8 players (shirt, shorts, socks and ball).

REGISTRATION FEES FOR FALL 2010

- \$50 for Under-6 (players born between 8/1/04 and 7/31/05, or entering kindergarten in school year 2010/2011)
- \$50 for Under-7 (players born between 8/1/03 and 7/31/04, or entering 1st grade in school year 2010/2011)
- \$50 for Under-8 (players born between 8/1/02 and 7/31/03, or entering 2nd grade in school year 2010/2011)
- \$65 for Under-9 thru Under-14 (players born between 8/01/96 and 7/31/02)
- \$75 for Under-15 thru Under-19 (players born between 8/01/92 and 7/31/96)

EVALUATIONS

**Evaluations will be held on May 22nd & May 23, June 5th & 6th with rain dates of June 12th & June 13th
(More information to follow in a separate letter)
Players must attend an evaluation to be eligible for a travel team**

Late Registration: Late registration will be online from April 7th through May 9th. Any returning player registering after this date will be placed on a waiting list, and will only be added to a team if an opening exists in their appropriate age and gender division. Players missing late registration will not be guaranteed placement on a team. Late fees will be \$25 for U9 and older players and \$10 for U7 and U8 players.

Volunteers: We are actively seeking ways of improving our activities and raising the level of coaching. As always, WE NEED VOLUNTEERS in all areas and encourage you to step forward at registration. All positions, including board members and coaches in EYSA are volunteer. Please consider volunteering some of your time to keep Exeter Youth Soccer a successful program for the youth of our community. EXETER YOUTH SOCCER ASSOCIATION FALL 2010 REGISTRATION

Registration refunds will only be given under the following conditions:

1. Player withdraws prior to June 30, 2010.
2. Player sustains an injury prior to the first league game which prevents him/her from participating in the remainder of the season.
3. Player on a late registration wait list is not placed on a team.
4. Upon board approval for any other reason.

Insufficient Fund Policy

Payment in full is expected at the time of registration by credit card, check, cash or money order. Checks should be made payable to "EYSA".

Persons issuing checks to EYSA that are returned for "insufficient funds" ("bounced checks") must immediately reimburse EYSA for the full registration fee and any associated bank fees or charges. Failure to do so will result in nullifying the registration, and the child will not be permitted to participate in the program for the current season. A second offense concerning returned checks will force EYSA to accept "cash only" from the offending party in all future transactions covering the registration fee and any associated bank fees or charges.

Coaches, Assistant Coaches, and other EYSA representatives or officers are advised not to pay registration fees (or other fees required by EYSA) on behalf of players who promise to reimburse them. EYSA will not accept any responsibility for non-reimbursement in these circumstances.

Player Eligibility Policy

EYSA will accept any player who resides in Exeter Township, or attends school in the Exeter Township School District, Antietam School District, Daniel Boone School District, Saint Catharine of Siena Regional School or Immaculate Conception Academy. Any other person desiring to play for EYSA must submit a written request for consideration to the EYSA Board of Directors stating where he/she resides and why he/she desires to play soccer for EYSA.

Age Level Determination

Every player must register in his or her natural age group according to the Eastern Pennsylvania Youth Soccer Association's birth date chart. A younger player may elect to register in the same age group as their school classmates as their natural age group.

Players may petition to play at an age level higher than their natural age group ("playing up"). In order to be considered at the higher age level, **the player must attend the evaluation session for both age groups**. If the player rates in the top 1/3rd of the players at the higher age level, they will be eligible for selection to a team in the older age group. If the player rates in the lower 2/3rd of the players at the higher age level, they will not be eligible for selection to a team in the older age group. **Playing up does not necessarily guarantee that a player will be a member of a Division I travel team.**

All players wanting to play up during the fall season must go through the player evaluation process every year. Qualifying for a specific team one year does not guarantee that player will automatically be placed with the same team or coach in later years.
